

LEGO Technic 2017: Endless adventures by sea, land and in the air!

- A total of ten new LEGO Technic sets will ensure challenging building in the first half of the year
- In 2017, the LEGO Group will celebrate 40 years of LEGO Technic

Munich, 31 January 2017. Whether exploring unknown terrain, going on deep-sea expeditions or reaching lofty heights, a total of ten new LEGO Technic sets will fill the first half of 2017 with adventure. From January 1st, LEGO fans can look forward to nine new models. From March, an additional set will add even more building fun. So, the 2017 product range will continue its tradition to provide both Technic and LEGO fans of all ages with small and real challenges as in the last four decades.

On to high speed

With two new sets, thrills are guaranteed for all fans of big shows: The LEGO Technic Stunt Truck has a pull-back motor so it can hurtle over the stunt ramp that is included in the set. Furthermore it can be combined with the LEGO Technic Stunt Bike, which also has a pull-back motor, to create the Power Racer combi model for lots more stunt options. Both models have extra wide rims for extra grip during their stunts. The LEGO Technic BMW R 1200 GS Adventure is yet another motorbike with proper grip. Made from 603 parts, this model was conceived in close collaboration with BMW Motorrad and combines innovative design with the art of engineering. The LEGO Technic BMW R 1200 GS Adventure has the characteristic lines as the full-size model, while the colour scheme in blue and black also imitates the original. Special technical highlights include the visible shaft drive and the 2-cylinder boxer engine that is typical of BMW Motorbike and is set in motion as soon as the motorcycle is moved.

Adventures by land, water and in the air

The **LEGO Technic Ocean Explorer** will head for the high seas in the first half of 2017. For real seafaring adventures, the set features a bridge with radar, a crane and a helicopter, plus a submarine. If one prefers soaring above the clouds instead of diving under the sea, he can take off with the **LEGO Technic Air Race Jet**. Available from March 1st, the vertical takeoff aircraft features a Power Functions motor that adjusts the jet nozzle to vertical or horizontal takeoff position. As with almost all LEGO Technic sets, the LEGO Technic Air Race Jet is a 2-in-1 model for rewarding build-and-play experience and can be rebuilt to create a Private Jet. Technic fans who would rather have their feet on solid ground can explore the toughest terrain with the remote-controlled **LEGO Technic RC Tracked Racer**. Thanks to its robust tracks large obstacles and 360° turns are not a problem for the vehicle.

40 years of LEGO Technic

So, adventurous missions by land, water and in the air are guaranteed with the new models this year. The LEGO Technic range has already inspired both children and adults since 1977 with detailed, challenging sets that provide joint building fun at all ages. As the LEGO Group is celebrating 40 years of LEGO Technic this year, a specially designed LEGO Technic element is hidden in every LEGO Technic set in 2017.
